Training

The aims & objectives of Stage 1 is to provide personnel, who have little or no experience of the Banksman & Slinger role, with the basic knowledge of activities associated with the combined roles, & the safety & regulatory requirements of those activities.

Initial training program allows the delegate to demonstrate basic Banksman & Slinger practical skills following instruction & demonstration by the training staff. This training programme aims to prepare the delegates for the next stage of the progression path to become a competent Banksman & Slinger i.e Stage 2: supervised workplace experience.

Assessment

Delegates attending Stage 1 Initial Training programme will be given a series of explanations & demonstrations. At the end of the course, delegates will be given a theory test which will allow them to demonstrate their knowledge & understanding of learning outcomes in all modules

- Module 1 Introduction to Lifting Operations
- Module 2 The Banksman Role
- Module 3 Slinging Operations
- Module 4 Practical Exercises

The Theory test pass mark is 80%, Practical exercises in Module 4 in which delegates take an active part is evaluated against learning outcomes specified in standard <http://www.opito.com/uk/library/standards-library.html>
